FAMILY NAME: Juncaceae

SCIENTIFIC NAME: Juncus canadensis Torr.

COMMON NAME/S: Canada rush

FAMILY NAME: Polygonaceae

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Polygonum cuspidatum* Siebold & Zucc. (Plant Life of Kentucky); Fallopia japonica (Houtt.) Ronse Decr. (iNaturalist). Note that iNaturalist does not list authorities so you will need to check elsewhere for this information (see http://www.tropicos.org/). **COMMON NAME/S**: Japanese knotweed (same common name from both sources)

FAMILY IDENTIFICATION NOTES: Reduced perianth parts and round stem indicate Juncaceae.

GENUS IDENTIFICATION NOTES: Easy to identify as *Juncus* due to round stem, fruit as a capsule, and perfect flowers with persistent chaffy tepals in a compact head.

SPECIES IDENTIFICATION NOTES AND DIFFERENTIATION FROM SIMILAR

SPECIES: lant has a similar appearance to *Cladium mariscoides*. However, flowers of *C. mariscoides* are clustered in spikelets and have achenes. Swollen joints in the leaves, tailed seeds and capsule shape are good indicators that this is *Juncus canadensis*.
